**ORDER GRANTING END PAYER
PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR
ATTORNEYS' FEES AND COSTS**

1 Pending before the Court is the End Payer Plaintiffs’ (“EPPs”) motion for an
2 award of attorneys’ fees and reimbursement of litigation expenses made in connection
3 with their class action settlement with Defendants StarKist Co. and Dongwon Industries
4 Co., Ltd. (collectively, “StarKist and DWI”) and Defendants Lion Capital (Americas),
5 Inc., Lion Capital LLP, and Big Catch Cayman LP¹ (collectively, the “Lion
6 Companies”). The EPPs also seek incentive awards from the settlement fund in
7 varying amounts ranging from \$3,000, \$6,000 and \$9,000 for consumers who acted as
8 Class Representatives for their service in this case.

9 Having considered the EPPs’ motion, the record in this case, and the supporting
10 papers, the Court finds EPPs’ request for attorneys’ fees, reimbursement of litigation
11 expenses, and incentive awards for each of the Class Representatives for their service
12 in this case is fair and reasonable considering the outstanding settlements obtained,
13 the substantial efforts Class Counsel have taken, the considerable litigation risks faced
14 by Class Counsel, and the extent of time and work that the Class Representatives have
15 put into this case over the last nine years. Accordingly, the Court **GRANTS** the EPPs’
16 motion and **ORDERS** the following:

17 (1) The Class Representatives shall each receive an incentive award as
18 follows:

1 b. \$6,000 each to Melissa Bowman, Michael Buff, Kathy Durand (f/k/a
2 Gore), Kim Eason (f/k/a Craig), Gloria Emery, Edgardo Gutierrez, Carla
3 Lown, Rick Musgrave, Corey Norris, John Pels, Rob Skaff, Greg Stearns,
4 Bonnie Vander Laan, and Julie Wiese.

5 c. \$9,000 each to Gay Birnbaum, Laura Childs, Andrew Gorman, Lisa Hall,
6 Mary Hudson, Jennifer Nelson, Barbara Olson, and Elizabeth Twitchell.


7 (2) Class Counsel is awarded a total of \$1,618,489.24 in past litigation
8 expenses since May of 2021 and fees of \$48,320,739.40.

9 (3) The fees and expenses shall be allocated among Class Counsel by the
10 EPPs' Lead Counsel (Wolf Haldenstein Adler Freeman & Herz LLP) in a manner that,
11 in the Lead Counsel's good-faith judgment, reflects each firm's contribution to the
12 institution, prosecution, and resolution of the litigation.

13 (4) This order shall be entered of this date pursuant to Rule 54(b) and (d) of
14 the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the Court finding that there is no just reason for
15 delay.
